Innovation born of tradition

INSIGHTS



When our company founders Emil and Adolf Becker opened the doors to their workshop in Sinn in May 1921, their motivation was to offer solutions that make life easier. This idea has remained with us to this day.

The roots of our company go back to a small mechanical workshop, where Emil Becker, working on his own, laid the foundation for what would become our brand today. At the very location where our administrative headquarters now stands, he began with great dedication and skilled craftsmanship. It soon became clear that further development would not be possible without mechanical production. However, the financial means for the necessary investments were lacking. At this crucial point, Emil Becker received strong support from his brother Adolf, an independent master electrician. He joined the company as an equal partner – a perfect complement that made their shared success possible.

In the early days, the focus was on manufacturing gears. Just a few years later, up until the outbreak of the Second World War, Becker had earned an excellent reputation as a respected gear-cutting company. After the war, the company resumed operations, initially offering gear-cutting as contract manufacturing. However, with the economic upswing of Germany's post-war "Wirtschaftswunder," a pivotal decision was made: Becker began developing and producing a modern steering gear for the popular three-wheeled trucks manufactured by the Hamburg-based company Tempo. The patented steering gear proved to be a great success and was produced in large quantities and exported worldwide until the late 1960s. Becker quality "Made in Germany" began to conquer international markets.

1965 marked an important turning point in our history: with the development and production of gate drives and corresponding control units for industrial applications, Becker entered a new business field. This move proved to be a valuable foundation when, in 1971, the product portfolio was expanded to include electric drives for roller shutters and sun protection systems. The development of electrical and electronic control units represented another significant milestone – paving the way for future innovations.

Since 2013, Becker has been breaking new ground with the introduction of its own home control unit, CentralControl. This system allows roller shutters, sun protection, electrical devices, and lighting to be controlled centrally – even remotely. Our continuous development in the field of smart home technology demonstrates that we are well equipped for the future and are actively helping to shape technological progress.

Despite all our successes and international orientation, Becker has remained a family-owned company. Today, Hans-Joachim Wiegelmann, the grandson of Emil Becker, and his three sons are actively involved in the company's management as shareholders. Since 2023, Maik Wiegelmann has been leading the company as Managing Director, supported by Carsten Schwarz, who joined in 2024 as Commercial Director.

Becker has grown into an internationally sought-after provider. Several hundred thousand drives for roller shutters, sun protection systems, and other applications leave our plant in Sinn each year, along with our international subsidiaries. Companies from around the world turn to us for advice on technical challenges and place their trust in our innovative strength and the quality of our products.

Our focus is on smart solutions for home automation that combine comfort, security, and energy efficiency. It is the added value created by our team that strengthens our customers' trust. One example is our bidirectional radio system CentronicPlus, which has been continuously developed since 2018 and is setting new standards in the industry.

Since 2024, Becker has carried a new company logo and the claim for you. forever. Three words, one promise: for our customers, for our partners, for a sustainable future. Our redesigned circular emblem symbolizes the diversity of our work – from movable roller shutters and sun protection solutions to innovative radio technology and sustainable concepts for our planet. Another key focus is the **promotion of electromobility**. The vehicle fleet is being gradually electrified – for years now, priority has been given to acquiring plug-in hybrid vehicles (PHEVs) and battery electric vehicles (BEVs). The necessary charging infrastructure has been generously scaled, is powered by green electricity, and is available free of charge not only to employees, but also to customers and suppliers.

RELIABLE TECHNOLOGY

Our products are used in a wide variety of projects – from smart single-family homes to complex commercial properties. Whether it's private dream homes, modern office buildings, hotels, or unique places like a chocolate museum – wherever reliable drive and control technology is needed, customers trust Becker solutions. Chocolate Museum in Cologne

At the Chocolate Museum in Cologne, 141 façade awnings in the office wing were comprehensively modernized. Powerful and quiet sun protection drives were installed, combined with a modern radio control system. Control is handled flexibly by individual office users as well as by sun and wind sensors. The entire implementation was carried out during ongoing operations with a high degree of technical precision.



Hotel „Hammermühle“

At Hotel Hammermühle, the outdoor terrace was transformed into a weather-independent space using 8 XXL sun umbrellas and 16 transparent roller windows. The roller windows, made of UV- and weather-resistant PVC, are equipped with radio-controlled drives and can be operated almost silently via hand transmitter. This allows up to 140 guests to enjoy the lakeside terrace year-round – regardless of rain or wind. The flexible outdoor area offers significant added value, especially for wedding celebrations, and greatly enhances the appeal of the venue.



Athletics Hall of VfB Stuttgart

In the athletics hall of VfB Stuttgart, a custom sun protection system ensures optimal training conditions. Seventeen seamless ZIP screens, each 6.30 meters high, shade the glass façades while still allowing an unobstructed view to the outside. The vertical awnings are operated via wired drives integrated into the hall's KNX system, enabling flexible adjustments to weather conditions and user needs. This guarantees a glare-free and comfortable indoor climate for the professionals all year round.



Sun Sail for a Single-Family Home

An innovative double-triangle sail, with a 7-meter wave span and dual-sided extension, provides effective sun protection. The system is operated by a radio-controlled sun protection drive, complemented by a solar-powered sensor that reacts to sunlight and wind, automatically extending and retracting the sail. High-quality materials, such as stainless steel posts and a UV-impermeable, waterproof sail fabric, ensure optimal protection and comfort for terraces, balconies, and window façades.

Multi-Family Residence on Lake Constance

In the center of Friedrichshafen, a residential building with 11 apartments was constructed, blending harmoniously into the historic surroundings with its traditional mansard hip roof. Aluminum roller shutters were installed on 61 windows, each fitted with ultra-quiet EVO drives. Thanks to BLDC technology, these drives can operate in a range of motion profiles – from dynamic to whisper-quiet. Control is handled via traditional wired switches, while a Bluetooth option supports convenient commissioning.
