Setting up the Alexa Skill for Becker-Antriebe CentralControl

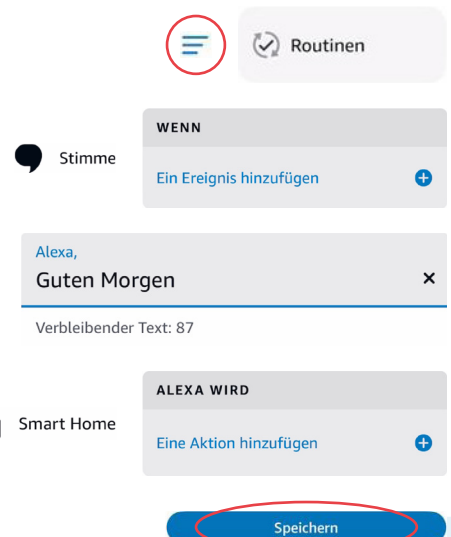
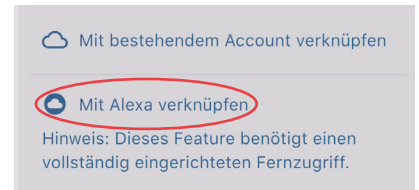
- Open the CentralControl app
- Select CentralControl CC41
- Every action or command that is to be triggered by voice must first be created as a scenario
- Open settings
- Select „Link with Alexa“
- Select „Open Alexa“
- Confirm „Open in Alexa?“

- Select „ENABLE TO USE“
- Log in to Becker-Antriebe
- Select „Link account“
- Continue by confirming
- Alexa will automatically link to the available CentralControl CC41
- Confirm „Next“

3

- The system will automatically switch to the Alexa app
- Open the menu via the „three lines“
- Select „Routines“
- Tap the „+“ to create a new routine
- In the „WHEN“ section, add an event
- Select the „Voice“ tab
- Choose the scenario trigger and continue
- In the „ALEXA WILL“ section, add an action
- Select the „Smart Home“ tab
- Choose and add the desired scenario
- Save



Make sure that your CentralControl CC41 is properly registered on the Becker gateway server (gw.b-tronic.net). This is free of charge and required for linking the Alexa Skill.

Only scenarios can be triggered by Amazon Alexa.
